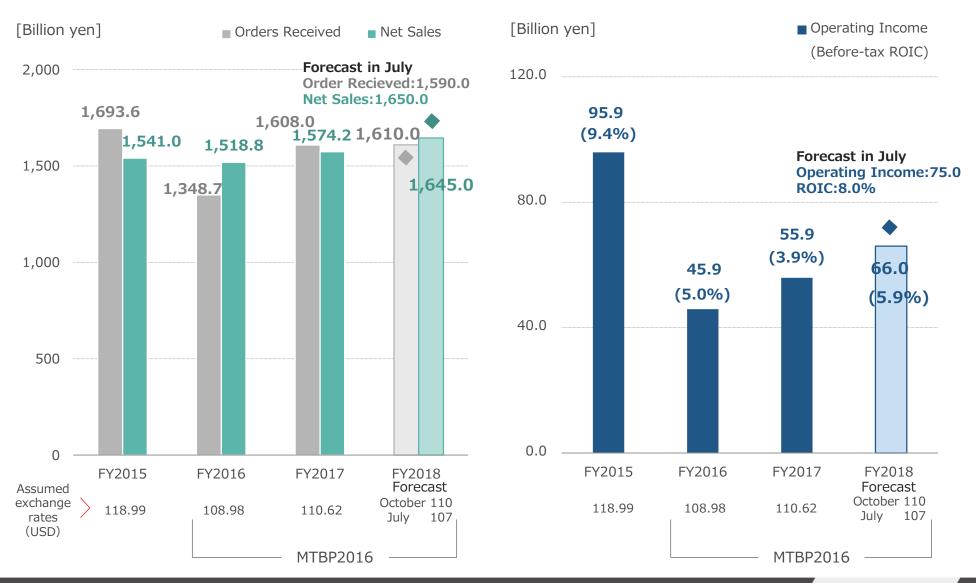

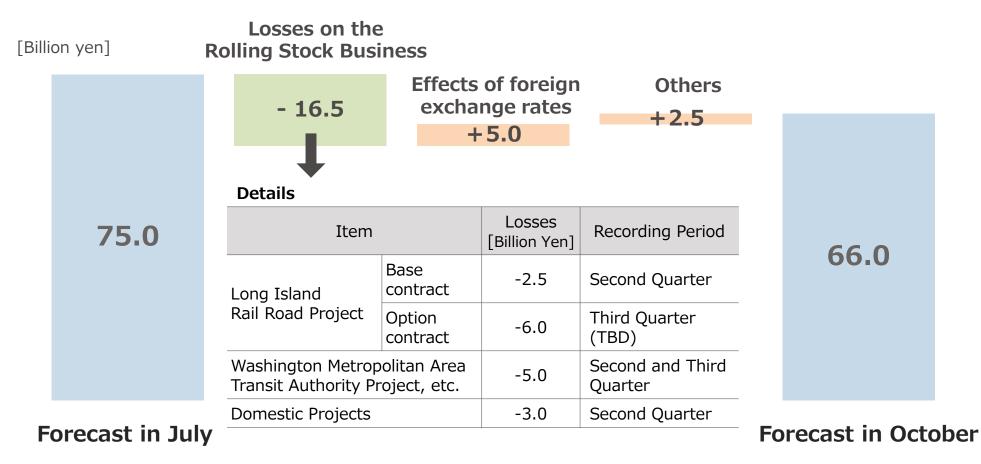

(July: 75.0 Billion yen  $\Rightarrow$  October: 66.0 Billion yen)



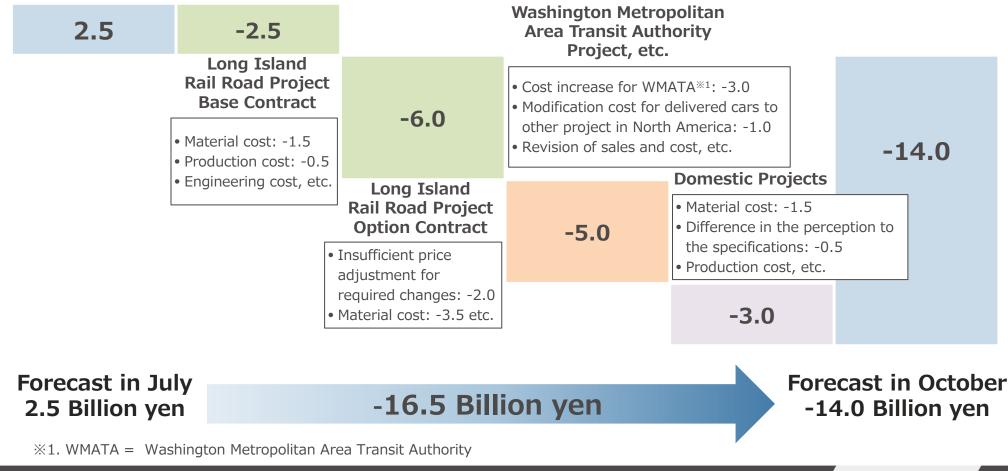
